The plays include:

**Bad Sunday** by Mark Wale is a masterpiece of physical comedy. Join a dysfunctional Irish family on a Sunday afternoon drive as the cast works their magic with a few props and a willing audience.

**Rising of the Moon** by Lady Gregory is a beautiful one act play first performed in 1907 that captures the deep conflict in the heart of an Irish policeman (indeed in all the Irish people) between the duty to maintain the status quo and the deep longing for freedom..

**The WorkHouse Ward** by Lady Gregory is a comedy about the Irish art of argument for the sake of argument.
